

**FAIRVIEW AREA SCHOOLS' BOARD OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
APRIL 6, 2020**

A special meeting of the Fairview Area Schools' Board of Education was held Monday, April 6, 2020 online only via the Go To Meeting platform.

I. Call to Order

Board President Anne Tompkins called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

II. Roll Call

III. Approval of Agenda – The agenda was approved by Board consensus.

V. Superintendent Update

Mr. Sattler provided the following update on news from the State and plans for the remainder of the school year:

1. The district is in the process of developing a plan for continued learning. The plan must be approved by the ISD by April 28. Mr. Sattler would like to have it approved by the end of this week so we may begin implementing it next week.
2. Still working out whether student work packets will be delivered or if pick-up times will be established.
3. Teachers are to stay in contact with their students.
4. Third quarter grades may be improved upon but not reversed.
5. The district will continue to pay staff as if they were still working. Hourly staff will be paid through June 5.
6. Graduation is postponed (not canceled) at this time. Any senior in good standing as of March 11 will graduate. Any student not in good standing will be given opportunity to improve his/her grade in order to graduate on time.
7. The ISD will provide a template for continued learning for Special Ed students.
8. Information regarding the district's plans for the remainder of the school year will be sent to parents either by formal letter or blast by the end of this week.

VI. Continued Learning Update

Amy Clouse provided an update on the district's plan for continued learning.

1. Collaborative plans were emailed to K-5 teachers and 6-12 teachers in order to share and collect learning ideas, parent resources, etc.
2. Elementary teachers will be cleaning out student cubbies and organizing items to return to students.
3. The contact person for each grade is the student's teacher.
4. Students need to check their email for information from their teacher.
5. The district is able to amend the learning plan as needed.
