Certified High School Guidance Counselor

The position requires working closely with administration, staff, students, and parents.

Duties:

- A. Provide a full array of academic and career counseling services to students
- B. Develop student interventions and guidance programs
- C. Plan, monitor and direct the 4-year process to student graduation (Michigan Merit Curriculum)
- D. Interpret and communicate group and individual standardized tests to students, staff and families
- E. Coordinate and participate in orientations, graduation, awards nights and other school functions
- F. Coordinate and promote dual-enrolled programs, Career Tech, and Early College opportunities
- G. Develop and maintain high school schedules, grades, and transcripts
- H. Maintain appropriate, confidential records and provide timely reports
- I. Perform other duties as assigned by administrator
