

**FAIRVIEW AREA SCHOOLS' BOARD OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
JUNE 22, 2016**

A special meeting of the Fairview Area Schools' Board of Education was held on Wednesday evening, June 22, 2016 in the high school media center.

I. Call to Order – Roll Call – Welcome

Since the majority of Board members wish to repost at a later date, a permanent Superintendent was not hired at this time. Mr. Sandy is contracted to work as Interim Superintendent through June 30, 2017. The Board will rely on Mr. Sandy's vast experience to help the district move forward.
